Conditions of entry

1. Entries are limited to two artworks per individual student or tutor. This limit applies even if you have taken more than one course.
2. No entry fee is required.
3. Entry is open to individuals who have attended courses at Tresillian Arts Centre:
Term 4 2025, Terms 1, 2 & 3 2026.
Work is to reflect skills acquired within the course attended. The exhibition showcases the skills acquired by students of Tresillian art courses, as well as Tresillian art tutors.
4. Items not-for-sale should be marked 'NFS'.
5. All 2D artwork must be either framed or mounted with a backing board and matt, ready for hanging. Framed artworks should have suitable hanging devices (D rings with nylon poly cord). Please no sawtooth hangers. Unframed, mounted artworks will be hung with bull clips.
6. Unframed canvas/board artworks that are well presented and finished on all sides will be accepted.
7. Bowed or warped artwork (framing or stretcher bars) will not be accepted.
8. If you have any special display requirements for textiles, jewellery or 3D works, please discuss with Tresillian staff at drop-off.
9. All artworks must be finished and dry at the time of delivery.
10. All due care will be taken with artworks. However, the City of Nedlands will not take responsibility for any damaged or stolen artwork. Artists are responsible for insuring their own artwork during the exhibition if they choose to do so.
11. The City of Nedlands reserves the right to reproduce all entries in print and electronic media for the purpose of promotion of this exhibition.
12. In the event that not all artwork is able to be hung due to space constraints, a selection process will take place by the curator.
13. While every effort will be made to display all artworks, the curator and TAC Coordinator have final say on display decisions.
