




Tresillian Courses

With four term programs each year, there is a wide variety of courses on offer including arts, languages, handicrafts and wellbeing. A quarterly school holiday program for children and youth provides an opportunity to learn new skills in a fun and creative atmosphere. We also offer a range of after school art classes, for children aged 7 - 16 years.


Learn to Draw




Portraiture - Painting from Life and Photographic Reference


Introduction to Renaissance & Venetian Art History



Develop your painting techniques with acrylics, a versatile medium that can be used in many ways. Colour theory, drawing skills and different genre are taught in this class.






Cold Oil Encaustic Painting

Mixing oil paints with a cold encaustic paste will reveal a versatile medium, which provides both impasto and translucent qualities and is fast drying. Jean-Louis joins us this term from France, for this rare opportunity to learn this technique.
